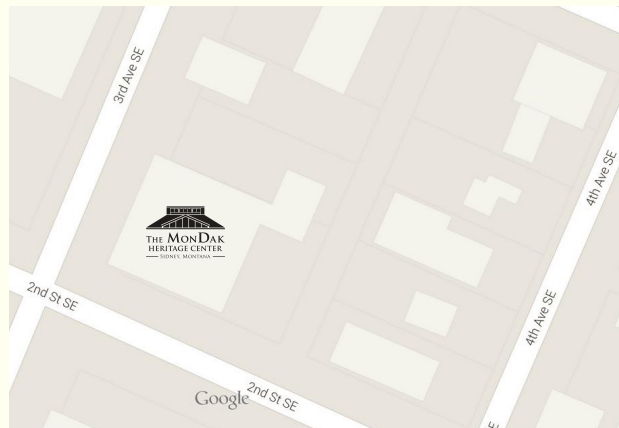

The MonDak Historical & Art Society formed in 1967 and first opened a museum called the J. K. Ralston Museum and Art Center six years later in the “old hospital” in Sidney, Montana. Named after Ralston, the famed Western artist and Richland County native, the Ralston Center operated for twelve years until the museum moved to the MonDak Heritage Center in 1984.
