As always for the non-beer drinkers, there will be wine and punch available. Doors open at 6:30 with the entertainment scheduled to commence at 7:00 pm on Friday, October 27th.

Pub Night is the annual combined fundraising event, formerly known as HarvestFest, for the Northeastern Arts Network and the MonDak Heritage Center. Proceeds from this event support live music, exhibits, programs, and collections preservation at the MonDak Heritage Center and enable the Northeastern Arts Network to bring music and educational programs to area schools. Pub Night this year features Rebecca Folsom. Colorado singersongwriter Rebecca Folsom believes every lyric, every note, every musical collaboration carries the potency to change the world. Moving with ease through her four-octave range she plucks the instrument of the heart with

tender fearlessness and fiery passion all meant to awaken unfettered aliveness. Her new album Sanctuary has been rated Number 1 on the National Roots Folk Radio Charts for 2 months running! Rooted in folk and gospel, Rebecca has played on BBC television, Red Rocks Amphitheater, the Bluebird, and Opryland as well as numerous festivals nationwide. She was a semi-finalist in the 2021 International Songwriting Competition with her song "Sanctuary". In addition to recording 12 albums, Rebecca has written and published two books of poetry and created numerous paintings of fine art which will be on display at this event. With Rebecca's songs, you might find yourself singing along, dancing, weeping, or raising your hands in motivated celebration to rise up and live into our greatest human potential.

Featured Exhibits

"One Defined to Be No One" Sean Chandler October 11— December 10



Sean Chandler (Aaniiih) grew up in Glendive, Montana, and his family was among the only Native family in the community. He received his BA in Art and MA in Native Studies at Montana State University in Bozeman. He later earned an Ed.D. in Educational Leadership from the University of Montana while employed as Director of American Indian Studies at Aaniiih Nakoda College on Fort Belknap Agency in Harlem, Montana. Recently, he was promoted to president of the College in August 2020.

His pieces range from oil, acrylic, paint stick, and charcoal on large canvases to drypoint prints and drawings. He cites Blackfeet artist Ernie Pepion (1943– 2005), Salish Kootenai artist Corwin Clairmont, and Bozeman-based artist Jay Schmidt as mentors.



DAWSON COLLEGE STUDENT ART SHOW October 11—November 11

Students from Dawson Community College in Glendive currently have a variety of their works on display in the MDHC north gallery. This exhibition contains 29 art pieces from ungraduated students; many pieces are by Art Majors. The artwork on display has been completed in drawing, painting, 2D design, and illustration. Art classes are instructed by Jennifer Wheeler.



33rd Annual Miniature Art Show November 15—January 13

"MADE OF PRAIRIE" SABRINA RAMSEY

NOVEMBER 15—JANUARY 13



Sabrina Ramsey of Williston, ND has an amazing lens for capturing the beauty of eastern Montana and North Dakota. This exhibit features photographs highlighting the four seasons and homesteader relics of northwest North Dakota and northeast Montana on wrapped canvas. Most pieces are 44 x 22 but there are some smaller images, as well. Ramsey turns every day scenes like grass fields with rusty cars into views of interest and color. Each photograph tells a story of the seasons and places of the MonDak.



COMMUNITIES WEST V DECEMBER 13—FEBRUARY 3

Communities West V is a biennial exchange in its 10th year of existence. This iteration is the most ambitious to date, bringing together over 70 printmakers, ranging from



those in the heart or twilight of their careers alongside emerging artists. The folio was created with the intention of building community among printmakers living in or with unyielding ties to the Western United States.

The curators of this exhibit state "As the organizers of the project and members of the Western printmaking community, we have a vested interest in reinforcing the printmaking community in the west. In addition to building community, we are slowly building a naturally evolving survey of printmakers identifying with the West.


